For the Confidential Destruction service we will provide you with the following;

- All material is handled within secure areas and by our security experienced employees. This starts at the
 collection by our trained drivers in tracked vehicles, followed by our processing plant which is contained and
 manned by 24hr security cameras.
- GHS will provide you with a signed consignment note on collection, ensuring the peace of mind that a trained GHS member of staff has collected your documents.
- All GHS staff are security trained and follow the 'Confidential Shredding' service promise.
- A 'Certificate of Destruction' will be raised for every collection. This is a verified confirmation by GHS to confirm all material collected has gone through the shredding process.
- A 'Waste Transfer Note will be issued to cover Government 'Duty of Care' regulations.
- We keep an audit trail of all your collections. This includes collection dates, quantities, weights and the collection driver.
- The material collected is destroyed by shredding in our industry recognized AXO shredder, baled, then pulped (cleaned off all print) before being put back into the recycling stream. We recycle all paper.
- Upon request we will provide you with strong GHS Recycling hessian sacks and cable ties.
- Upon request GHS can will provide you with a selection of confidential storage bins to suit your needs.
